(a.) of carrying out on a site the construction, erection, installation, reconstruction, re-erection, renovation, alteration, demolition or maintenance of or repairs to any of the following:

Employees

For full eligibility (ability to claim for all types of courses) the employee must demonstrate their work on the eligible site to be:

- An onsite construction, installation and / or fabrication activity;

For OH & S courses only, the employee must demonstrate their work on the eligible site to be:

- A Supervisory, Inspecting or Surveying activity
